Methodology used:

The KPI Graduation Rate calculation is based on tracking individual students who entered a program of instruction in a particular entry year, and assessing how many of those individuals completed the program over 200% time frame. The 2008-09 KPI Graduation Rate is based on students who started one-year programs in 2006-07, two-year programs in 2004-05, and three-year programs in 2002-2003, and who had graduated by 2007-08.
