Selection Process for Applicants

Candidates to the program will be assessed on their academic achievement, the results of their portfolio and questionnaire, and participation in an information session.

Applicants selected for the program will be notified by mail and their Sheridan email account. These decisions will not be released over the phone. Fee, registration and timetable information will follow. Classes for the fall term begin Tuesday, September 7, 2010.

Instructions for Applicants

After applying to the program **some** applicants will be asked to:

Register for IN-PERSON Portfolio Evaluation

Your portfolio gives you an opportunity to display your ability to follow instructions accurately and provides us with insight into your problem-solving abilities. Matted work is acceptable. A flat portfolio case is recommended. Mail-in portfolios will be accepted from applicants living more than 80 kilometres from Sheridan.

The portfolio should contain 10 to 12 pieces of your strongest work. It may include: photographs, drawings/sketches, paintings and/or other artistic media, submitted as photographic prints. We are not looking for technical perfection. We are looking for artistic potential and the ability to take on a variety of subjects (i.e., portraits, landscapes, still life etc.)

Essay: Provide typewritten answers to the following questions in your portfolio:

- Why do you want to study Applied Photography at Sheridan?
- What is your goal in the photographic field? (typed on a separate piece of paper)
