Selection Process for Applicants

Eligible applicants are selected on the basis of their academic achievement, and/or demonstrated experience, portfolio assessment and questionnaire. Postsecondary transcripts, indicating courses completed to date, must be submitted at the time of application.

Applicants selected for the program will be notified by mail and their Sheridan email account. These decisions may not be released over the phone. Fee, registration and timetable information will follow. Classes for the fall term begin Tuesday, September 7, 2010.

Instructions for Applicants

After applying to the program **some** applicants will be asked to:

1. Submit a portfolio.

When sending your portfolio, please put jpeg images (maximum of 20) into one folder on your CD (Windows or hybrid) or DVD (NTSE) for easy viewing. Make sure that they are clearly labeled. If you have any examples of film (video, animation etc.), please edit them down to a maximum of 2 minutes in total. Be sure to indicate the work you did for each piece or example (i.e. camera operator only, animation only, model and texturing only, composited building in background, produced all elements etc.). Think about what you are sending. We need to see examples of work done during your studies (animation from an animation program, designs from a graphic design program etc.). When sending your work, make sure that it is what you think is your personal best, NOT what you think we would want to see. Check to see if your disk will play on different platforms and/or players. See that the playing surface is not scratched. And lastly, please make sure that your disk is clearly labeled with your name and student number.

2. Respond to the following question:

Why are you applying to this program? (approximately 500 words, typewritten)

3. Submit a résumé.
