### **Selection Process for Applicants**

Eligible applicants are selected on the basis of their previous academic achievement. Applicants who do not possess a senior-level visual arts credit at the (M) or (Open) level will be required to submit a portfolio and a letter of intent.

Applicants selected for the program will be notified by mail and their Sheridan email account. These decisions may not be released over the phone. Fee, registration and timetable information will follow. Classes for the Fall term begin Tuesday, September 6, 2011.

### **Instructions for Applicants**

After applying to the program, applicants will be asked to:

Write a statement that describes your reasons for selecting the Crafts and Design Program. Your responses should articulate the following:

- In addition to your formal education, what other courses, workshops or shows related to the arts and/or crafts field have you previously attended?
- Describe any work experience, either voluntary or paid, which has motivated you to pursue further education in the field of crafts and design.
- How did you become aware of Sheridan's Crafts and Design Program?
- What knowledge and/or skills do you hope to learn during your studies in the Program?
- What are your future goals upon graduation from Sheridan?

**Portfolio**

You are required to submit a portfolio that includes 2-dimensional work, which must fit in a 9" x 12" envelope. Please show ten (10) images (digital prints or photographs) of your creativity. This may include drawings, paintings, design work, sculpture, photography, completed projects in any applicable craft media or anything you feel may support your application for your first choice of studio. Be sure to label and describe each image. Please do not send original artwork or CD ROMS. Please include a stamped, padded manila envelope with your address on it so that we may return your portfolio.
