Selection Process for Applicants

Eligible applicants will be selected on the basis of their previous academic achievement and the results of Sheridan's pre-admission test.

Academic achievement may be demonstrated through:

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or equivalent, including required courses; OR
- Results of Mature Student Testing

Additionally, ALL applicants MUST complete Sheridan's new pre-admission test for health occupations. A \$50 assessment fee will apply. Payment must be made by cash or debit card; credit card payment is not accepted.

Applicants may also be required to demonstrate English language proficiency through testing.

Applicants selected for the program will be notified by mail and their Sheridan email account. These decisions may not be released over the phone. Fee, registration and timetable information will follow. Classes for the Fall term begin Tuesday, September 4, 2012.

Instructions for Applicants

In order to continue in the admissions process, you must:

Register online for pre-admission testing. Further instructions will be provided to applicants of the program.

Additional Information

1. Pre-exposure rabies immunization is mandatory for this program. If accepted in this program, you will be required to present a current acceptable record of immunization to their field placement prior to the start of the placement and at their own expense.
2. Veterinary Technician students will be required to spend between \$800-\$1,000 on laboratory supplies and equipment, textbooks, lab coat and scrubs.
