### One-Time Ancillary Fees

### Sheridan Student Union (SSU) Health and Dental Plan

You will be required to pay the Sheridan Student Union Inc. (SSUI) Health and Dental Plan fee in full. The SSUI Health and Dental Plan is a valuable service provided by your Student Union to fill the gaps left by provincial health care. The Plan fee is \$312.00 for full-year coverage (Sept. 1, 2022 - Aug. 31, 2023).

If you are already covered by an extended health and dental plan, you can opt out of the SSUI Health and Dental Plan by providing proof of other equivalent health and dental coverage. The SSUI Health and Dental Plan is for domestic students only.
