***Note:**

The graduation rate is based on tracking individual students who entered a program of instruction in a particular enrolment reporting period and assessing how many of those individuals completed the program a number of years later. For each program of instruction, students who transfer out are removed from the group that is being tracked and those who transfer in are added.

The program duration used to establish a student's program completion time frame equals approximately 200 per cent of the normal program duration with the exception of applied degrees where a seven-year completion period is provided. For example, the 2010-11 KPI Graduation Rate is based on students who started one-year programs in 2008-09, two-year programs in 2006-07, and three-year programs in 2004-05, and who had graduated by 2009-10.
