What is a Learn Well (LW) PAL Leader?

LW-PAL Leaders (Learn Well Peer-Assisted Learning Leaders) provide program specific academic support to first-year students within Sheridan's Learn Well Virtual Communities. The LW-PAL Leader serves as an academic peer tutor to help students with questions related to weekly course content by hosting virtual drop-in group tutoring "study hall" sessions. During these sessions, the LW-PAL leader can help students review notes, discuss readings, develop study skills and prepare for tests and assignments. Sessions are interactive and provide students with an opportunity to ask questions and check their understanding of course material previously taught in class.

Job Description

- PAL Leaders are second-year students or higher who hold an average **>76%**
- PAL Leaders are paid **\$14.43/hour**
- PAL Leaders work **5 hours** per week
- PAL Leaders host weekly interactive study halls for first-year students in their program

Typical Weekly Schedule

- 5 hours of hosting pre-scheduled "live" virtual study hall sessions for students within their program
- Session schedules are developed in collaboration with the PAL leader.

Training

All PAL Leaders attend training before the beginning of the term provided by Learning Services, the Centre for Teaching and Learning and Accessible Learning. The role provides the opportunity to engage with other student leaders and access leadership development as well as become part of a community of leaders at Sheridan.
