1 Why Use The PAL Program?

PAL Leaders reinforce what you teach in class. The program contributes to the retention, progression, and graduation of students. The program is 100% funded by Sheridan's Learning Services.

2 Recommend Your PAL

PAL leaders are students who have completed the course with a grade of **76% or above** and who require a **faculty referral** for the position.



3 PAL Leader Role

- Review and/or re-attend lectures
- Act as a model student
- Host weekly study sessions to help students review notes, discuss readings, develop study skills and/or prepare for tests and assignments.

4 Professor's Role

- Allow your PAL leaders to make weekly announcements on SLATE/in-class regarding study sessions as well as host discussion boards in SLATE.
- Connect with PAL Leaders weekly (online or via email) to review and provide guidance on study session content.

How do I Recommend PAL Leaders?

Once you know your course qualifies for the PAL program through the Tutoring Centre, ensure you have posted the **PAL job posting to your SLATE course**. HR standards require that all students have the opportunity to express interest in the role.

Provide the **campus, course code, and the number of sections** you would like PAL Leaders to support by filling out the PAL List Excel file shared with you via the Tutoring Centre.

3

Provide **PAL Leader recommendations for each course section** by filling out the PAL Excel file shared with you via the Tutoring Centre.
