



## Program Moves to HMC

### Section 1: Questions relating to the building opening delay

#### 1. When will the new building open?

Sheridan expects the building to be ready for classes in January 2017, at the start of the winter term, as opposed to the original date of September 2016.

#### 2. What is the cause for the delay?

The delay in the completion of the building is due to a number of factors beyond Sheridan's control, including slower than expected construction, and factors preventing Sheridan from conducting a significant amount of its own work to furnish and equip the building as it is not yet fully complete, clean and secure. As a result, we expect the building to remain an active construction site during the Fall 2016 term.

#### 3. Why was the delay not foreseen sooner?

The decision to delay the opening of the building was made only when Sheridan was absolutely certain that the building could not possibly be ready in time for the delivery of classes in September. This decision was based on Sheridan's own monitoring during the construction process, and the opinion of an Independent Certifier.

#### 4. Which programs are impacted?

The following table lists all impacted programs and their temporary locations for the Fall 2016 semester:

### **5. How will this impact the programs that were scheduled to run at HMC starting Fall 2016?**

All students and employees were sent an email to their Sheridan email account specifying program locations for the Fall 2016 term. No programs have been cancelled as a result of this building delay.

### **6. Can I get a refund and attend a different program/another college?**

If you are a new student, please contact the Admissions office to inquire about changing programs or to withdraw. If you are a student returning for a subsequent term and would like to withdraw, please speak with an Advisor at Student Advisement.

### **7. Can I defer my acceptance so that I can be in the new building, instead of coming to an alternate location this September?**

Yes. If you are affected by this delay, you have two options. You can defer your acceptance to January (for programs that have a January intake – not all programs do) or you can defer your acceptance to September 2017. Programs with a January intake include: Advertising and Marketing Communications; Advertising and Marketing Communications Management; Tourism-Global Travel; Interior Decorating; Architectural Technician; Architectural Technology. Programs with intake in September only include: Honours Bachelor of Interior Design and Visual Merchandising Arts. If you are a returning student, please speak to your records specialist. If you are a new student, please speak to Admissions.

### **8. I have already rented an apartment in Mississauga in anticipation of starting my program at HMC in Fall 2016. How will Sheridan accommodate this situation?**

We appreciate your frustration. This is not the outcome we desired.

In order to support students in impacted programs, we have tripled the frequency of our courtesy shuttle bus service for the Fall 2016 term, including adding busses directly between HMC and the Davis and Trafalgar campuses. So, one option is to use the free Sheridan shuttle bus to travel to your alternate location for the 14-weeks of the fall term. At the start of January, your program will be offered in the new building in Mississauga. During the Fall 2016 term, we will be adding additional shuttle buses to

## 9. Can I register for cross-campus enrolment?

Campus capacities are currently at a maximum for the Fall 2016 term. We expect to open cross campus enrolment in the Winter 2017 term when we are able to distribute enrolment differently.

## Section 2: Program Moves Questions

### 1. Why is my program moving?

Enrollment at Sheridan continues to grow. Additional teaching and learning spaces are needed to maintain our emphasis on small class sizes. The new building at HMC will make room for another 3,200 students, in 29 new classrooms and 28 new studios, labs and production spaces.

Very careful thought was given into which programs would move.

In some cases, the programs were chosen because they complement the Sheridan Business diploma and degree programs which are already offered at HMC. These business-related programs which are moving include: Advertising, Marketing, Visual Merchandising, Public Relations, and Tourism – Global Travel.

HMC will also be home to a group of programs with the Built Environment as a common thread, taking advantage of the new building's purposeful design as a living lab that showcases how we will make it one of the most energy efficient educational buildings in Canada. This group includes programs in architecture, interior design, interior decorating.

Related programs are being clustered together so that expertise and resources can be shared. Having related programs grouped together also makes it easier for students to collaborate with peers and/or move between credentials.

### 2. Which other programs are moving?

### **3. When will this take effect?**

The programs will run in their new campus location beginning in the winter term (January, 2017).

### **4. Why was my program chosen – why can't a different program go to HMC?**

Some programs were chosen because they complement the Sheridan Business diploma and degree programs which are already offered at HMC. These business-related programs which are moving include: Advertising, Marketing, Visual Merchandising, Public Relations, and Tourism – Global Travel.

HMC will also be home to a group of programs with the Built Environment as a common thread, taking advantage of the new building's purposeful design as a living lab that showcases how we will make it one of the most energy efficient educational buildings in Canada. This group includes programs in architecture, interior design, interior decorating.

### **5. What if I don't want to move?**

Beginning in the Winter 2017 term, your program will no longer be offered at your current campus. In order to continue in your current stream of study, you will be required to attend our Hazel McCallion Campus in Mississauga.

## 6. Is my program being phased out?

No. Sheridan is not cancelling any programs related to this move. Your program will continue to be offered – it will just run at a different location.

## 9. What amenities will be available in the new building?

The new building will introduce an additional **cafeteria**, a full-service and Grab-and-Go **Tim Hortons**, a **campus book store**, a **print centre**, **bike storage and showers**, and a **public gallery** that will showcase student and faculty projects and displays. These amenities are available to all Sheridan students.

## 10. What other amenities are available at HMC?

HMC1 includes has a full-service **Health Centre**, providing physical and mental health services to Sheridan students. Physicians are available, by appointment. Registered nurses can be seen on a drop-in basis.

HMC1 also includes a multi-faith **Prayer Room**, a **cafeteria**, a full-service **Starbucks**, a **Library** and **Learning Commons**.

## 11. Does HMC have a gym?

While HMC does not have its own gym facilities, students receive a membership at the Mississauga YMCA which is a short distance from campus. The YMCA is located at 51 City Centre Dr #800, Mississauga, ON L5B 1M7.

The YMCA facilities will be available to all HMC students, including those impacted by the delay whose classes have been moved to the Trafalgar and Davis campuses during Fall 2016. Impacted students will also have access to the gym facilities on their temporary campus.

Students must be registered in and attending classes in order to access the YMCA. To enter the facilities, students scan their OneCard directly at the YMCA, which acts as their access card.

## **12. May I continue to live in Sheridan residence in Brampton/Oakville and commute by shuttle?**

The Sheridan Shuttle will continue to operate in the 16/17 year academic year. Students in programs moving to HMC can continue to live in residence at the Trafalgar or Davis campuses and commute by shuttle if they wish. In order to support students in impacted programs, we have tripled the frequency of our courtesy shuttle bus service for the Fall 2016 term, including adding busses directly between HMC and the Davis and Trafalgar campuses.

## **13. How will expansion affect parking at HMC?**

As a result of the expansion at HMC, Sheridan has entered into a new agreement providing its employees and students the option to park at the Cineplex/IMAX 'Theatre Lot', located at the NW corner of Rathburn Rd. W. and Living Arts Dr. Beginning September 2016, an additional 153 spaces will be made available to Sheridan students and employees in this lot (for a total of 473 spots in this lot).

Annual, one-semester and two-semester hangtag permits are available for the Theatre Lot. Permit Fees are the same as at Sheridan's other campuses and HMC Sheridan permits are valid at all campuses.

In addition to the Theatre lot, there are two City of Mississauga 'pay and display' surface lots on the West Side of the Hazel McCallion campus. For information on operating hours and City permits, visit the [City of Mississauga's website](#).

Students and staff who have already purchased an HMC Sheridan permit for the Fall Semester and who wish to switch to the City permit option will receive a full refund on the Sheridan permit through the Parking Office upon returning the permit to Security.

**Please refer to the permit prorate information that follows this table for students and employees who will not be studying or teaching at HMC beyond the Fall Semester, i.e. who will be at another Sheridan campus or whose hours will not extend into the evening at HMC.**

### Prorated Permits

The Parking Office will pro-rate subsequent Sheridan semester permit fee(s) for students/employees displaced to evening classes/work at HMC for Fall semester and who will be returning to another campus or who will work or study during daytime hours at HMC during the Winter and Spring semesters.

To be eligible for a discounted Sheridan permit, the following documentation will be required by the Parking Office:

1. Receipts from City of Mississauga monthly permits (or the actual permits)
2. A class schedule (Fall Semester 2016) or proof of extended work hours (note from Manager)

The Parking Office will consider a maximum \$260 (4 x \$65 monthly permits) against subsequent Sheridan parking permit fees in the 2016/17 academic year.

For example: a student/employee displaced to HMC (evening classes/work) for Fall Semester, who pays \$260 in parking fees to the City for the Fall Semester, who will be returning to another Sheridan campus in the Winter semester (or whose time on HMC campus will end by 6 pm), and who wishes to purchase two-semester worth of parking, will be eligible to receive a Sheridan permit for the Winter semester at the **discounted fee of \$220** ( $\$260 + \$220 = \$480$ , where \$480 is the value of a Sheridan two-semester permit).

The same scenario would apply to three-semester worth of parking. The **discounted fee of \$315** would apply. ( $\$260 + \$315 = \$575$ , where \$575 is the value of a Sheridan annual/three-semester permit).

The restrictions outlined in the permit grid above would apply.
