As you are likely aware, the faculty union has scheduled a strike to begin on Monday, October 16. This strike impacts all of Ontario's 24 public colleges. We understand that this situation is difficult for everyone, and concerning to you, our students, and we appreciate your patience. Our top priority continues to be our students' education, and it is our hope and expectation that all students will have the opportunity to complete their term and their learning goals for the year.

In the event of a strike on Monday morning, the Sheridan website will be updated with the red notice bar. Should negotiations resume and the strike be averted, we will inform our community immediately.
