Revised Dates for Exams and Assignments

Dear Sheridan Community,

As a result of the labour disruption at all Ontario Colleges, including Sheridan, no exams will be taking place this week and no assignments will be due for full time and part time students while classes are suspended and while a strike is in effect.

Students are encouraged to continue to work on their current assignments and may submit them through their normal channels during a strike, however, students will not be penalized for missing any original deadlines that fall within the strike period.

For all **Continuing Education** classes that are still running during a strike, **all deadlines for assignments and evaluations/examinations continue to remain valid**. Students are expected to hand-in all course work according to the scheduled due dates and attend all evaluations/examinations as scheduled.

Please note that Sheridan will also not allow any of the cancelled exams to be rescheduled any earlier than 72 hours following the announcement that the strike has ended. Similarly, the earliest that assignments will be due is 72 hours after the announcement that the strike is over.

Specific revised dates for exams and assignment deadlines will be communicated following the end of the labour disruption.

It has not been determined yet how quickly classes will resume following an announcement that a settlement has been reached and that the strike is ending.

It is possible that classes may resume faster than 72 hours after a settlement is reached, however, no exams will be scheduled and no assignments will be due during this 72 hour window.

As soon as information becomes available to us, we will continue to share it with you.
