Update on the Potential Faculty Strike

Dear Sheridan Community,

We would like to provide you with a brief update and clarification on the potential faculty strike. On September 14, faculty at Ontario's 24 colleges voted in favour of strike action if a settlement is not reached by September 30, when the current collective agreement expires.

As has been reported in the media, the earliest possible date for strike action is October 15. However, we would like to clarify that there is no guarantee that a strike will occur, or when it will happen, as the union may choose to delay action by weeks or even months. Colleges will receive five days' notice should a strike be called, at which point the Sheridan community will be notified.

Sheridan and the rest of Ontario's colleges remain committed to achieving a negotiated settlement with the union, to avoid a strike. Our first priority remains our students' learning.
