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Selection Process for Applicants

Candidates to the program will be selected based on their academic achievement (in progress or completed) and the results of their portfolio evaluation. Note: transcripts and grades are NOT used in assessing the portfolio.

Applicants selected for the program will be notified through their Sheridan email account. These decisions may not be released over the phone. Check your Sheridan email account frequently. Many of the communications you receive from Sheridan come to you exclusively via your Sheridan email account. Fee, registration and timetable information will follow. Classes for the fall term begin Tuesday, September 7, 2021.

Academic Integrity

By submitting your Admission Requirements, you are agreeing to comply with Sheridan's Academic Integrity Policy. The Academic Integrity Policy states:

Sheridan College is committed to upholding the highest standards of academic integrity. The International Centre for Academic Integrity (ICAI) defines academic integrity as “a commitment, even in the face of adversity, to six fundamental values: honesty, trust, fairness, respect, responsibility, and courage. From these values flow principles of behavior that enable academic communities to translate ideals into action”.

Applicants who are found to have falsified transcripts, cheated on admission tests, or submitted fraudulent documents or in any other way attempted to circumvent the admissions process in a manner inconsistent with the principles of academic integrity, will not be granted admission to the College. Those applicants will be ineligible for admission to any Sheridan program or course for a period of not less than 5 years, after which admission to the College will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

For programs where a portfolio submission is required as part of the admission process, portfolio work should represent an applicant's own ideas, writing, projects and creations. Where others have contributed, or non-original ideas have been included, applicants will give proper recognition and reference.

Online Portfolio Submission Requirements

Submission of these portfolio requirements will be online. Submission details will be provided to applicants once Sheridan receives their application.

In order for us to continue to process your application, you must follow these directions carefully:

Portfolio and Letter of Intent Requirements:

By submitting a portfolio to Sheridan College, you acknowledge that you completed the portfolio independently, it was not created by another person, and you did not use anyone else's work.

Your Portfolio must follow these guidelines:

1. Submit 10–12 pieces of your strongest photographic work to date that demonstrate your engagement with photography as a form of personal expression.
2. A minimum of 10 out of 12 pieces must be photographs.
3. Presentation of your images must follow size and format guidelines and must consider image sequencing (order) and flow.

Submit a Letter of Intent as follows:

Please submit a Letter of Intent detailing your photographic experience so far, your goals as a photographer, and how choosing Sheridan's Honours Bachelor of Photography program would help you attain those goals. Your Letter of Intent should not exceed one page, 250 words.

The online submission system will open on November 1st, 2020. The deadline to submit portfolios for the first round of assessment is **February 23, 2021 (2:00 PM EASTERN STANDARD TIME)**. After this date, assessment will be made on a first-come, first-served basis for the remaining available seats.
