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Selection Process for Applicants

Successful applicants will be selected based on their previous academic achievement (in progress or completed).

Important Update as of February 8, 2021: The requirement to complete the 40 hours of work/volunteer practical experience with an Athletic Therapist or Sports Physiotherapist (SPD) has been waived for the 2021-22 Application cycle.

Applicants will be notified of a decision on their application by logging onto their Sheridan Student Portal and Sheridan email account. Admission decisions will not be released over the phone. Fee, registration and timetable information will follow. Classes for the fall term begin Tuesday, September 7, 2021.

Academic Integrity

By submitting your Admission Requirements, you are agreeing to comply with Sheridan's Academic Integrity Policy. The Academic Integrity Policy states:

Sheridan College is committed to upholding the highest standards of academic integrity. The International Centre for Academic Integrity (ICAI) defines academic integrity as “a commitment, even in the face of adversity, to six fundamental values: honesty, trust, fairness, respect, responsibility, and courage. Applicants who are found to have falsified transcripts, cheated on admission tests, or submitted fraudulent documents or in any other way attempted to circumvent the admissions process in a manner inconsistent with the principles of academic integrity, will not be granted admission to the College. Those applicants will be ineligible for admission to any Sheridan program or course for a period of not less than 5 years, after which admission to the College will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

For programs where a portfolio submission is required as part of the admission process, portfolio work should represent an applicant's own ideas, writing, projects and creations. Where others have contributed, or non-original ideas have been included, applicants will give proper recognition and reference.

Attend a Virtual Information Session - Saturday, February 6, 2021 from 11am to 1pm. At this session you will have an opportunity to view a presentation, participate in a question/ answer period, meet with faculty, virtually tour the campus and see the Athletic Therapy facility.
