## Looking for Housing



**1. Know Your Budget** - Before you start looking for places to rent, know your budget and what works for you financially. Check out this [budget planner](#).



**2. Check Out Places4Students** - Check [Places4students](#) for postings around campus. This platform provides renting and subletting options, as well as roommate profiles for other students looking to rent.



**3. Location, Location, Location** – Always check the [location](#) of your potential renting options to have an understanding of the distance from the campus, local grocery stores, convenience stores, pharmacies, and access to public transportation.



**4. Living Situation** - When looking for the right place to live, the type of accommodation can make big difference in cost. Consider if you want to live with roommates or alone. A simple way to lower your housing cost is to live with roommates if you are looking at a shared accommodation.



**5. Shop Around** - Don't pick the first room you see, use a [checklist](#) and compare listings to find out what rental suits you best.
